Automated Funds Transfer (AFT) ServicesInformation & Pricing

- Credit push funds to, direct deposits (payroll, supplier/vendor payments)
 - Debit pull funds from, pre-authorized debits (ARs, rent, donations).
- 2-step security hard or soft tokens
 - Processed through a secured online website
 - DUAL authorization.
- Add and delete payors/payees and their banking details, make changes to your files, release files, access transaction records and confirm emails.
 <u>Data Entry</u> data to be entered into provided fields within Central 1's system.
 <u>File Upload</u> in-house or third-party software to generate files that are uploaded to Central 1's.
- Cut off time; recommended 2 business days before due, 7pm ET.
- AFT lets your business avoid not only the cost of buying, printing and mailing/couriering cheques, but also saves time ("in the mail") and the administration of depositing payments received; by electronically transferring funds from one account to another at any pre-determined date.
 - Saves time and money by replacing incoming and outgoing cheques and e-Transfers.
 - Strengthens the relationship with the Payee, direct deposit to their account.
